In our second Board Meeting we discussed all the advices with the Executive Board of the DUT. We are going to use some of the advices in the future to accomplish our goals.

DESKTOP COMPUTERS ON FACULTIES

On the 2th and 13th November ORAS was at your faculty to see how important students think desktops are at the university campus. A lot of students appeared to use the desktops, for several purposes. Most of the students pointed out that they have a laptop, but sometimes rather use a desktop. Reasons for using a desktop are: printing, which seems to work a lot better on desktops, and reaching out for specific software that is not available on your laptop. A nice tool to reach this software anyway is the 'Virtual Desktop': an ORAS initiative. Through weblogin.tudelft.nl, or through the 'Citrix Receiver' (en. ORAS.nl/Tools/) you can log in on your TU Desktop and use for example Photoshop, Illustrator, and also Matrixframe. A nice feature for Apple users too!



UPDATE BOARD MEETING

The student council has had its monthly meeting with the board of executives on November 27th. Several subjects are discussed, like the collaboration between student councils within de IDEA League and a new partnership between the TU Delft and The University of British Columbia. For ORAS it is very important that more exchange possibilities are available for students, which we underscored during the meeting. Furthermore we have also expressed our concerns about the shortage of study places at the campus. We strongly emphasized that the current situation is not tolerable anymore, especially during the weekends and exam periods. The board will be working on this. Would you like to know more?
